


# Explanation of the CSS in Digication

This detailed chart has been created to guide you and to explain what each part of the CSS will change in the visual style of your ePortfolio, focusing mainly on the color scheme. It is to be used along with the “Customizing the Theme and Editing the CSS of Your ePortfolio” tutorial. Some sections will require advanced understanding of CSS and have been noted in the chart. <pre>/*   The “properties” inside the   curly brackets control   elements such as color, type   treatments, position, ect. You   can modify the following css   elements to customize your   pages style.   */</pre>	<p>The text between /* and */ are comments that were left by the CSS developer about the CSS they created and are meant as a reference for those who are looking to edit the CSS.</p>
<pre>body {   background:#EEEEEE;   color: #222222; }</pre>	<p><b>Background:#EEEEEE;</b> This part of the CSS will change the background color of the page. In this example, changing #EEEEEE to #FF0000 will the change the background to red (See image 1.1)</p>  <p><b>Color: #222222;</b> This part of the CSS will change the color of text in the following areas of the ePortfolio: <i>Welcome Text, Default Module Text, Leave a Comment Text, Posted Comment as Text and Platform Provided as Text</i>. In this example, changing #222222 to #ff0000 will change the mentioned text to red. (See images 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5 and 1.6)</p>

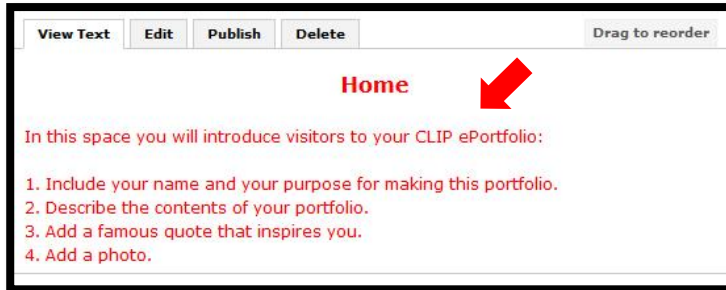

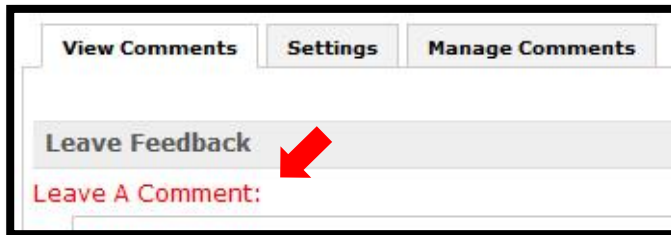

**color:#000000;**

This part of the CSS will change the color of the site navigation at the top of the page. In this example, changing #000000 to #ff0000 will change the site navigation text to red. (See image 1.7)

*/\* The header is the area at the top of the page above the title, while the #main\_container is the center content of page.\*/*

padding-bottom:0.5em;  
padding-top:10px;  
}
```

This will change the padding of the header container (**Understanding of CSS required**)

background-color:#FFFFFF;  
border-color:#FFFFFF;  
border-style:solid;  
border-width:0 10px;  
position:relative;  
}
```

**Background-color:#FFFFFF;**

This part of the CSS will change the background of the e-portfolio. In this example, changing #FFFFFF to #FF0000 will change the ePortfolio background to red. (See image 1.8)

**Border-color:#FFFFFF;**

This part of the CSS will change the border color of the ePortfolio. In this example, changing #FFFFFF to #FF0000 will change the border color to red. (See image 1.9)

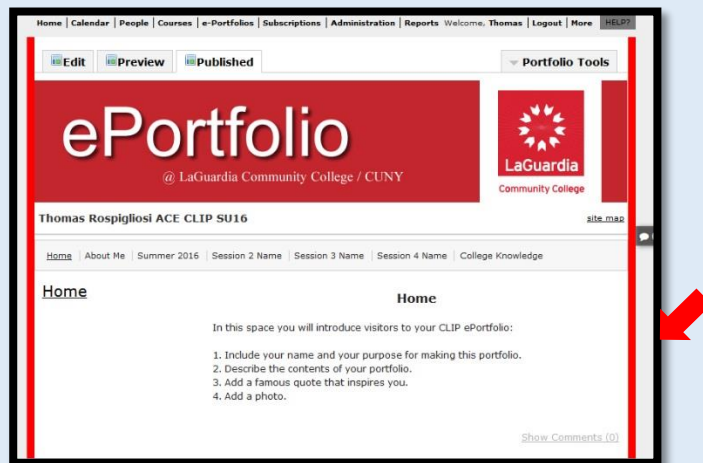






	<p><b>position:relative;</b> This part of the CSS will change the border properties for the main container (<b>Understanding of CSS required</b>)</p>
<pre>#header_container .title { border-bottom:2px solid #CCCCCC !important; padding:15px; }</pre>	<p><b>Border-bottom: 2px solid #CCCCCC !important</b> This part of the CSS will change the color, thickness and padding of the header containers bottom border. In this example, changing <b>#CCCCCC</b> to <b>#FF0000</b> will change Border-bottom to red (See Image 1.10)</p>  <p>Image 1.10</p>
<pre>/* The module_topnav controls the navigation within your pages and content.*/  #module_topnav{ border: 1px solid #ccc }</pre>	<p><b>border:1px solid #CCC ;</b> This part of the CSS will change the border color and border thickness around the e-portfolio navigation (<b>viewable only in the published mode</b>). In this example, changing <b>#CCC</b> to <b>#FF0000</b> will change the border of the Module topnav to red (See Image 1.11)</p>  <p>Image 1.11</p>
<pre>.navigation_topnav { background-color:#f7f7f7; }</pre>	<p><b>background-color:#f7f7f7;</b> This part of the CSS will change the background color of the ePortfolio navigation. In this example, changing <b>#f7f7f7</b> to <b>#FF0000</b> will change the background color of the ePortfolio navigation to red (See image 1.12)</p>  <p>Image 1.12</p>
<pre>.navigation_topnav a { color:#222222; font-family: Verdana,Helvetica,Arial,sans- serif; }</pre>	<p><b>color:#222222;</b> This part of the CSS will change the color and font style of the ePortfolio navigation text. In this example, changing <b>#222222</b> to <b>#FF0000</b> will change the ePortfolio navigation text to red. (See image 1.13)</p>  <p>Image 1.13</p>
<pre>/*The #footer is for the content at the bottom of your pages and can be customized to fit the look and feel you are looking for. */  #footer_container { background:none;</pre>	<p><b>border-top:1px solid #AAAAAA;</b> This part of the CSS will allow you to change the thickness and color of the footer container border-top. In this example, changing <b>#AAAAAA</b> to <b>#FF0000</b> will change footer container border top to red. (See image 1.14)</p>  <p>Image 1.14</p>

<pre>border-top:1px solid #AAAAAA; }</pre>	
<pre>.title{ display:block; }</pre>	This part of the CSS will change the display of the title <b>(Understanding of CSS required)</b>
<pre>#footer { background:none; }</pre>	This part of the CSS will change the settings for the footer <b>(Understanding of CSS required)</b>
